
Partnership with TWU

• Format of the Program

- Applicant Screening Event- December 15, 2016
- 50% of applicants were Denton ISD graduates
- Fall 2016- Three applicants, three placements (2 were offered BIL teaching positions in DISD)
- Spring 2017- Eight applicants, three placements which aligned to budget for Fall 2016
 - The stories behind the student teachers
 - Proposed Action- funding approval for remaining 5 student teachers
