SUBJECT: ARCHITECT SELECTION AND METHOD OF DELIVERY FOR

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

BOARD GOAL: Keller Independent School District facilities and services will

be operated in a safe manner so that all students and

employees may thrive in a secure and nurturing environment.

All systems in the Keller Independent School District will be effective, efficient, and accountable in support of the district's

mission.

FISCAL NOTE: 2005 Bond Funds

Background Information:

- It is necessary to select an architectural firm to prepare contract documents for capital improvements for the 2005 Bond issue.
- At the same time, it is necessary to select a method of delivery for this project.

Administrative Considerations:

- This work includes:
 - Security Cameras and building entrance modifications at elementary campuses
 - Re-roofing and roof repairs at nine campuses:
 Florence ES, Park Glen ES, Shady Grove ES, Chisholm Trail IS, FHMS, FRHS and KHS Field House and Administration Building
 - Modifications to accommodate Life classes at four campuses: FRHS, Florence ES, FHMS and Parkview ES
 - Exterior grading and drainage at two campuses: Heritage ES, FHMS

- Due to the number of occupied sites involved and the unknown scope of this project, an
 architect familiar with a majority of the campuses and the District standards would
 provide a good choice. For the same reasons, Construction Manager at Risk also would
 benefit this work.
- These items were discussed with the Facilities Committee on October 19, 2006.
- Based on the direction provided by the Facilities Committee, we have determined that VLK Architects would be the most qualified selection for Architect and CM @ Risk will provide the best value for construction.
- Due to the complexity and scope of this work, we recommend a traditional 7.25% Architect's fee for remodel work. The Contract for Architectural Services is provided under separate cover.

The administration recommends the approval of VLK Architects for planning of the Capital Improvements work in the 2005 Bond. The administration further recommends CM @ Risk as the method of delivery for this work.
