Background Information

November 2023 the Duncanville ISD community approved a \$170M bond that allows the district to address priority maintenance and security needs, replace aged transportation, reconfigure campuses, add more choice instructional options, and expand career and technical education programs.

Phase One of the district reconfiguration plan focused on renovating all campuses while transforming select schools into specialized campuses and establishing school choice academies and signature programs to expand student opportunities. The phase also reconfigured grade spans to minimize campus transitions by creating an Early Learning Academy for 3-year-olds, shifting elementary schools to PK4–5, and middle schools to grades 6–8. Finally, the district rezoned campuses into feeder patterns aligned to Duncanville High School to strengthen instructional coherence and improve fiscal and operational efficiency across the system.

In Phase 2, the district plans to continue reconfiguring schools to better serve students while right-sizing operations to align with enrollment and capacity trends. Several campuses will be rezoned to improve efficiency in both district operations and transportation. Finally, new programs will be implemented to ensure families have clear, equitable access to enrollment services and district support programs.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board approve the proposed Phase 2 reconfiguration plan for the 2025/2026 school year.
