## **RATIONALE:**

A governmental body must respond to a public information request within 10 business days, not including weekends or state and federal holidays. Texas House Bill 3033 allows a governmental body to designate a day on which the governmental body's administrative offices are closed or operating with minimum staffing as a non-business day. Governmental bodies may designate 10 non-business days each calendar year. These designated days by the school district must be approved by the Board of Trustees. The only days that are not included within "business days" are Saturday and Sunday, national holidays or state holidays.
