**DESCRIPTION:**

The BHS science teachers have engaged in the district Continuous Improvement Process (CIP) review tasks over the past two years in the RESEARCH and PILOT phases. They have been active in activities that have included:

- review of state standards
- discussions of preferred resources
- consensus-building to reach recommendation decisions

These tasks have now culminated into the Curriculum Adoption Proposal (CAP) report being presented to you for review at this time. The recommendations included here provide excellent student opportunities that align with the goals of the state standards, as well as the local identified improvement process goals for each department.

This review process has allowed an opportunity for our BHS science teachers to reflect upon the future learning experiences desired for BHM students. Upon completion of the review process, the team is bringing forth recommendations for consideration within their CAP report. Preliminary budget figures are listed below.
