- 2. Landing place for students who have no motivation or desire to learn.




Primary Expectations

Blended Learning Centers





Blended School House Model

- Serving students in grades 5-12
- Optional 2 days face to face instruction virtually, onsite, or home visits
- 3 days a week teachers conduct family support
- Learning Centers open daily for extra teaching and support.
- IDEA Services through Special Education to include: Speech/OT/PT

Career and College Advising

- Creating High School Apprenticeships and dual enrollment courses with local community colleges
- Developing training partnerships with trades and businesses
 - Forging partnerships with Arkansas businesses
 - Concentrating on trades, industry & manufacturing, STEM related careers
- Academic opportunities for dual enrollment courses with local community colleges and universities
 - Tutoring and mentoring with a strong focus on financial literacy
 - Partnerships with career professionals in a work study program.



- According to ADE's homeschool report statewide there were 20,331 students in 17-18 which has since increased to 30, 205 students in 21-22.
- To this point in Arkansas Education, there has not been comparison of testing from Arkansas public school students or those that learn in a different environment.
- FLA could be used in the long term as a research study to shape the future of education.

- DESE approved digital learning curriculum monitored by certified Arkansas teachers.


