TOPIC: Approval of Grant Painting Award and Bid Results for Randolph Lockers

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the recommendation from our Owner's Representative, Plante Moran Cresa, to approve the Grant Elementary School painting award for an amount of \$96,759 and a contingency cost of \$1,700 and approve the bid for Randolph Elementary School lockers for an amount of \$23,400 and a contingency cost of \$1,800; for a total revised Elementary School Phase III project cost of \$9,958,917 and authorize Assistant Superintendent for Business Services to negotiate and execute final contracts with the contractors on behalf of Livonia Public Schools' Board of Education.
