3. 6th Grade Resource Room Novels Proposal

Assistant Superintendent Bordner presented a proposal to add two novels to the Sixth Grade Resource Room curriculum: *The 6th Grade Nickname Game* by Gordon Korman and *A Wrinkle in Time* by Madeleine L'Engle. The Committee reviewed the proposed titles and accompanying materials. The proposal will be presented to the Board for formal approval.

4. GLMS Musical Theater Course Proposal

Assistant Superintendent Bordner presented the GLMS Musical Theater Course Proposal to the Committee. This course is a one-trimester elective class designed for middle school students to explore the fundamentals of musical theater: acting, singing, and dancing. The Committee reviewed the course materials and will present the proposal to the Board for formal approval.

5. Cultural Agility Update

Assistant Superintendent Bordner provided the Committee with an update on the District's ongoing Cultural Agility work. The District continues its partnership with Marcy Peake, founder and consultant at The Center of Cultural Agility.
