Crosslake Community Schools FY23 Academic Performance Evaluation Contract Period July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2025

The Academic Performance Evaluation is conducted to determine progress on overall student achievement at the school as evidenced by the school's attainment of the contractual goals in the charter contract and the school's performance according to the state's accountability system – the North Star system. This evaluation is conducted annually and is designed to provide an update on the school's performance on contractual measures to date. In addition to the annual evaluations, a final academic performance evaluation is issued as part of the school's summative renewal evaluation in the last year of its charter contract.

*In line with Minnesota's ESSA waiver, and due to the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic on data collection and usability, MCA, ACCESS, and MTAS data collected during the 2020-21 school year will not be used for accountability purposes. To this end, Osprey Wilds will provide a FY21 academic evaluation to all schools, yet will use FY19 data to inform accountability decisions (i.e. renewal, etc.) until FY22 data becomes available.

Summary Analysis: The school had strong performance through FY23. Five indicators exceeded target (Mission Related Outcomes, Reading Growth, Reading Proficiency, Science Proficiency, and Other Proficiency or Growth), three indicators met target (Math Growth, Math Proficiency, and Post-Secondary Readiness), and one indicator did not meet target (Attendance). Areas of strength include Mission Related Outcomes, with 98% of seat-based students participating in a minimum of two out of three major community engagement activities, and Reading Growth, with the school meeting target on three measures and exceeding target on the other measure. Attendance is an area of concern, though there may be a discrepancy in the data as FY21 is listed as the baseline for seat-based consistent attendance, but the State did not report that data for FY21. This means that the internal number reported by the school should be re-checked for accuracy, as this is the number that will used for the whole contract term as a baseline, and may have an outsized impact on performance in this area. Another area of concern is for the FRP and Special Education student groups in the online program. The measures for these students did not meet target in Reading, and were more than 20 points below the online comparison schools in Science. The school should consider the supports in place for these students in the online setting, particularly as it relates to Reading and Science.

Overall, the school earned 106% of points through FY23. Based on performance to date, the school is on track to be "Eligible for Fast Track Renewal", per Exhibit P of the contract.
