NSBSD Strategic Plan Goal:

2.3.7 Implement common calendar that includes culturally sensitive local needs.

Recommendation:

The administration recommends the Board approve the SY18-19 school calendar revisions proposed by Kaveolook School, and Tikiġaq School.

Issue Summary:

Each year the School Advisory Council (SAC) in each community follows the Board Policy and Administrative Regulation on calendar development and recommends a school calendar to the Board. The administration made the process more flexible in order to allow a culturally sensitive calendar.

Kaveolook School experienced a weather related closure day Wednesday, February 13, and Tuesday, February 19.

Please note the following change:

- Sat, March 2 Regular school day for students and staff
- Sat, April 6 Regular school day for students and staff

Tikiġaq School experienced a water-pipe related issue in December which forced the rescheduling of their teacher work day.

Please note the following change:

• Sat, February 9 – Work day for teachers

Background:

Calendar requirements are limited to state law, Board Policy, negotiated agreements, and district inservice dates. Each school has 183 student/teacher days including up to ten in-service days, three teacher workdays, and six teacher holidays, for 192 total teacher days.
