RE: New Mexico State Appropriation – Transportation Summer Reading Program (27536)

During the 2025 legislative session, the state appropriated funding for costs associated with the New Mexico Summer Reading Program. The New Mexico Public Education Department (PED) has determined its FY24-25 planning award for transportation associated with the Summer Reading Program which is illustrated on Exhibit A. This funding is to be used specifically for to-and-from transportation costs associated with the Summer Reading Program. **Please note this award is only a planning award to establish budget authority**. Final allocations and disbursement will be based on actual miles and ridership reported on forms provided by PED. Failure to provide the forms to PED may result in reimbursement not being sent.
