POLICY ISSUE/SITUATION

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Subject: EMERGENCY DECLARATION; WATER QUALITY TESTING

In accordance with the criteria and authority prescribed in District Purchasing DJ-AR, I am declaring that an emergency now exists that requires prompt execution of a contract to provide water quality testing in all District schools and support facilities. As required by DJ-AR, the following findings are submitted for the record.

WE EMBRACE EQUITY

General circumstances leading to this declaration:

Recent drinking water testing at one school has found an elevated level of lead exceeding the EPA action level. Further analysis of the age, condition, and materials in plumbing systems District-wide has established the need to conduct expedited water quality testing in all District buildings.

Not foreseeable:

The presence of lead in the drinking water was not anticipated.

Risks:

Consuming water with elevated levels of lead poses a health risk.

Prompt contract remedy required:

Immediate testing of drinking water is best performed by an independent environmental services firm working with a certified testing laboratory.
