Re: Secondary Basketball Goal Replacement (Bond Project #38)

As part of the 2016 Bond Projects, all basketball goals, goal adjusters, goal wench systems, and goal padding are to be replaced at secondary schools (excluding gyms to be refurbished or repurposed at CMSE and CMSW). The elementary school basketball goal replacements are complete.

The Interlocal Contract purchasing method as provided in the Texas Education Code 44.031 was used to obtain proposals through TASB BuyBoard contract #412-13.

Academic Specialties provided the proposal with the best value for the district. Louis Macias was able to negotiate a better price with Academic Specialties than the TASB Buyboard pricing, thus saving an additional \$62,640 dollars due to the quantity of goals being purchased and installed. Academic Specialties' total turn-key proposal of \$223,892 is \$191,108 less than the \$415,000 budgeted in the bond program for the secondary schools. The pricing includes all materials, labor, installation, removal/disposal of the old equipment, and the purchase of the payment and performance bond. Academic Specialties is a long-time, well respected sports vendor in the state of Texas. We have used them many times, and have always been very pleased with their value and quality of work.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Coppell ISD Board of Trustees approve Academic Specialties as the contractor to complete the gymnasium basketball goal replacements at the secondary schools for the sum of \$223,892.00.
