TVAH has 309 students currently eligible for December Graduation and the support continues for those students as they are in testing this week and finalizing course work and credit recovery.

The high school campus is focused on supporting all students to earn the credits needed to finish strong this semester. Teachers who are not testing are providing work sessions and support

sessions to ensure that our students have access to these supports during the testing weeks. We are seeing systemic increases in academic success for our students year over year.

We are providing students support during the holiday break via the Holiday Zone which will allow students to engage with their peers and adults in a social online environment. Providing our at-risk students a touch point during a long break is crucial to their overall well being.

The leadership team is digging into our Interim 1 data now in order to have a strong Spring launch as we continue to prepare our students for end of course STAAR testing.

TVAH high school is also excited to be launching additional instructional programming this next semester that will allow our off-cohort students to work on academic coursework that will get these students back on a path towards graduation.

Counseling

Happy holidays and best wishes for the upcoming year from all of us in the TVAH Counseling Department!

This semester we started a monthly series for seniors and their parents to provide information about life after high school. In October, Kelly Woll, department captain, hosted a family night on how to select a college and complete college applications. The November meeting presented information on enlisting in the military. We were excited to have a recruiter present to answer questions. This month, we will be focusing on completing the FAFSA for the senior graduation requirement and for college financing. We look forward to continuing the monthly series in the Spring semester.

Credit Recovery has been successful as we schedule students in monthly cycles. During the September cycle, students earned 1,252 semester credits (.5) and during October, students earned 1,343 semester credits (.5). The credits that students are earning are helping them get back on track with their cohort year for an on-time graduation.

Our Graduation Ceremony 2025 has been confirmed for June 7, 2025 at the Comerica Center in Frisco again this year. With over 3000 Seniors, we will likely need to have three ceremonies. TVAH is excited to once again offer a prom after the ceremonies end. Hosting graduation and prom is one of our favorite times of the year.
