Purpose of Report

This report shows the attendance percentages for each grade level for the first grading cycle (August 26 – September 27).

Objectives

- District-wide totals are based on the number of students in each grade level.
- Attendance figures are taken from the PEIMS report.
- Attendance figures are based on 24 days (August 26 September 27).

Operational Impact

The attendance figures from PEIMS are used to determine the district ADA.

Results

- The total attendance average for the Denton ISD for Cycle 1 is 97.27%.
- The lowest total attendance averages are for 12th graders at 95% followed by PK at 96%.
- The highest attendance averages are in the 6th grade at 98.12% followed by 4rd grade at 98.10%.
- Comparison: 2012's first grading cycle was 97.44%.
