Great things continue to happen in HSA!

HSA is proud to announce that we have 17 students who are scheduled to graduate from the academy on January 30, 20245 in the PAC at 3:00 p.m. Pastor Travis from North Side Baptist Church will give words of encouragement to the graduates. Our HSA student speaker is a 2023 graduate, Tiara Castro.

HSA has successfully graduated 246 students since the start of the program in 2019, and we are still going strong. The success of the program is possible because of the dedication, support and the hard-work of the students and staff. It takes a village to raise a child, and the commitment by our board, district and campus leadership teams, and the strong, powerful collaborations with our community is equally important to the success of the program. We are a strong community who values our commitment to student success.

HSA is committed to meeting students right where they are and providing them with the social-emotional and academic support to help them thrive after they graduate from the academy. Our motto is to be the change and to give students the chance to succeed in life. They can, they will and they must, because failure is not an option for us.

HSA SPRING SNAPSHOT:

Students completed 80+ semester courses from January 1 through January 15, 2025.

In total HSA students have completed 380 courses since August 19th, 2024.

HSA Enrollment:

We currently have 60 students enrolled in HSA and 35+ students on the waiting list. Most of our cohort students are 24-25 graduates.

HSA NEWS FLASH:

- Students from SHSU Art Department & Health Science Department will work with our students this semester to provide Art Therapy Sessions and Mentoring/College Preparation sessions for our HSA Spring cohort students.
- HSA Spring Success 101 program will revolve around job skills and internships with SER jobs. Students will participate in gaining job and interview skills (Mar. 6, 2025) and College preparations for all HSA students whose post-secondary goal is to attend college or technical school in Fall 2024.

WHAT IS NEW AT HSA?

- Edgenuity daily progress goals for students continue as 20% daily for half-day students and 30% for all day HSA students. HSA now offers an A & B Session.
- HSA Adulting Spring Program will continue to offer several life-skill sessions on the necessities of daily living (how to change a tire, how to change oil, how to apply for an ID or Social Security card, how to prepare and live on a budget, how to set up a checking/savings account, etc). The goal is to ensure our students acquire real-life post-secondary essential skills for life.
- HSA will hold a job/career fair in May for current and previous HSA graduates. The job fair will
 consist of representatives from local businesses and technical college programs.
