Summary:

BISD Board of Trustees will be presented with an update on the BISD Advanced Academic programs including Gifted and Talented, PSAT/SAT, Dual Credit, and Advanced Placement.

- PSAT/NMSQT will be administered on the following dates:
 - October 17 PSAT/NMSQT All 8th, 10th and selected 11th graders
- SAT School Day will be offered on the following dates:
 - o March 19, 2025 All 11th graders and 12th graders by choice

Rationale

A district shall establish a process for identifying and serving gifted and talented students and shall establish a program for those students in each grade level. Under this provision, a district may establish a shared services arrangement with other districts. *Education Code 29.122*

The district may administer an established, valid, reliable, and nationally norm-referenced preliminary college preparation instrument to students for the purpose of measuring a student's progress toward readiness for college and the workplace. *EC 39.0261*
