Purpose of Report

This report shows the attendance percentages for each grade level for the fifth grading cycle (February 25, 2013 – April 19, 2013).

Objectives

- District-wide totals based on number of students in each grade level.
- Attendance figures are taken from the PEIMS report
- Attendance figures are based on 34 instructional days

Operational Impact

The attendance figures from PEIMS are used to determine the district ADA.

Results

- The total attendance average for the Denton ISD for Cycle 5 is 95.92%.
- The lowest total attendance average is for 12th grade students at 93.45 % followed by 11th grade students at 94.71%;
- The highest attendance averages are in the 5th grade, 96.92% followed by 4rd grade, 96.85%
- The 5th grade has had the highest attendance percentage each grading cycle.
