## **REASON FOR BOARD CONSIDERATION:**

Per Board Policy BBC: Board Member Resignation, the Board must announce Board Member resignations, declare the position vacant, and determine a process to be used in filling the vacancy.

Per Board Policy BBE: Board Vacancies, vacancies will be filled through Board appointment.

## **BACKGROUND:**

Clackamas Community College is governed by a seven-member Board of Education. Members, elected to four-year terms, represent each of the seven zones in the CCC College Service District. The Board oversees the development of programs and services, and the adoption of policies and budget to meet the needs of the college district. The Board generally meets the third Wednesday of the month.

Board Member Aaron Woods notified the College he was resigning from his position, effective April 2, 2025. In order to fill this position, the Board needs to declare Position 5 vacant and approve the process for filling the position. The vacancy will be advertised on the College's website and social media.

## Proposed timeline:

April 16, 2025 Declare Position 5 vacant. Approve process to fill position.

April 21 Position open for applications. Opening advertisement.

May 14 by 5 PM Deadline for applications.

May 27 - 28 Schedule candidate interviews

May 27 - 28 Deliberation and Discussion

June 2 Vote to Appoint the new Board Member at a Special Meeting
June 9 Oath of Office for new Board Member at a Special Meeting

The new Board Member will take office upon appointment and serve until June 30, 2027.
