Facilities Update - Lowell

- We are continuing to work with St. Louis County and area stakeholders to address the traffic issues at Lowell Elementary.
- We have met again with county officials to further consider options based on a great amount of community input.
- We will plan to finalize next steps within the next few weeks, but this issue will likely involve a variety of solutions throughout the next few years rather than one quick fix.
