TITLE: Approval of Course Fee Ranges for Continuing Education with Authorization for Market and Demand Adjustments

DISCUSSION: Ranges for per contact hour fees are being proposed for a broad range of continuing education courses. The proposed fees are based on costs of funding operations and are consistent with training in the North Texas market. Due to market changes and varied demands for training, the fees and courses may need to be adjusted to meet workforce, contract, and enrollment demands. Students enrolled in linked courses (continuing education classes held in conjunction with credit classes) will be assessed tuition and fees at the in-district credit tuition and fee rate.

DISTRICT PRESIDENT'S RECOMMENDATION: The District President recommends approval of course fee ranges for Continuing Education and authorizes the President or designee to adjust courses and fees as necessary to meet market and workforce demands.
