SUBJECT: Consideration and Approval of Corrective Action Plan – PEIMS Leaver Data	Submitted by: Erin Warren Related Pages: 1
BACKGROUND INFORMATION: On March 31, 2025, the Texas Education Agency (TEA) issued a notice to Luling ISD regarding a concern related to underreported PEIMS leaver data from the 2023–2024 school year. Specifically, TEA identified nine (9) students across Gerdes Junior High and Luling High School who were originally coded as leavers based on the information provided at withdrawal (e.g., transferring to another district, enrolling in homeschool, etc.). Subsequent follow-up by TEA determined that these students did not ultimately enroll in the destinations they reported at the time of withdrawal. As a result, the original leaver codes became inaccurate, leading to underreporting in the district’s official PEIMS submission. After reviewing preliminary findings and district-provided documentation, TEA determined that the matter may be resolved through implementation of a Corrective Action Plan (CAP), rather than through additional sanctions, provided that the district successfully completes all corrective steps.
