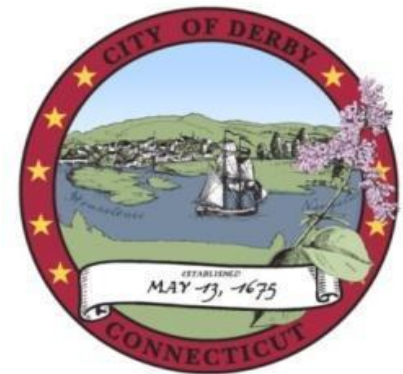

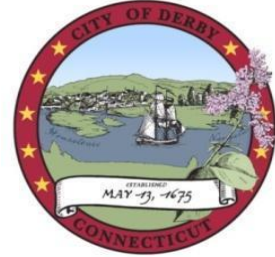

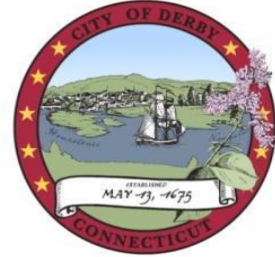
# Achievements

- Visited all the schools and spent time getting to know everyone.

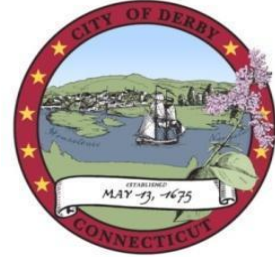
# Projects
