Fall 2024

- **Elementary Student Services:** 4th and 5th grade students are continuing to be offered services through a pull-out program. Grades K-3 and 6-12 students are being served through classroom teachers with K-3 receiving push-in services as needed.
- Secondary Student Services: Meeting one day a week at BMS and BHS during lunch. This is voluntary and have had a great turn-out. Google Classrooms created for all students 6-12 to upload evidence of learning twice a year as well as evidence of awards/honors/recognition. .BHS continuing to issue cords to seniors who meet the criteria upon graduation.
- **Transfer Students:** 12 students transferred from outside the school district and 3 transferred within BISD campuses.
- Coordinating Services: Shared resources, ideas, differentiation documentation spreadsheet, PD opportunities, and support through a google site with teachers.
- **Parent Night** on each elementary campus held during Open House, Title 1 Meeting, or Fall Fest. Materials regarding program were sent via school messenger to GT families 1-12.
- Referral and testing materials Materials were available on campuses during Open House, Title 1
 Meetings, Fall Fest, emailed, and/or handed out by classroom teacher.
- GT Coordinator's Meeting- October 17-Fabbiani scheduled to attend the 3-hour meeting.
- **GT files** reorganized by graduating year instead of tested year. Created a database of areas of giftedness and shared with 1st-6th teachers.
- Back to school: GT update meetings for teachers were held at Coggin EC-5, East, Northwest, Woodland, BMS, and BHS
- **GT professional development records** for teachers updated and shared with principals. Big push for K-3 teachers to obtain 30 hour training.
- 2nd grade screeners- Universal screeners will be a collaborative effort between GT teachers and classroom teachers through a Thinkapalooza event that was funded by Brownwood Education Foundation.
- Fall Testing Window will open late October.
- 23-24 School Year- Tested 88 students for G/T services.

Initiatives for the Gifted and Talented Program

- Monitor the progress of students in the program, identify students with potential, provide differentiated instruction, and offer enriching learning opportunities.
- Screenings and testing at all campuses are managed by G/T teacher.
- G/T teachers administer assessments and collaborate with selection committees.
- Communicate with the secondary schools to ensure compliance with state guidelines.
- Assist teachers by providing resources, guidance, and professional development sessions.
- Provide continued support to all stakeholders including students, parents, teachers, and administrators.

4th-5th Pull Out Services

The goal of the G/T program is to provide enriching and accelerated opportunities.

- Integration of project/problem-based learning and differentiated instruction that enriches, extends, and accelerates the grade level TEKS in the four content areas.
- Implementation of TPSP which is the gifted and talented curriculum used for independent projects.

G/T Services 6th-12th Grade

The goal of the G/T program is to provide enriching opportunities for identified students. Teachers do this through advanced products, advanced level courses, and differentiation.

- Learning is facilitated by teachers with the 30-hour required training.
- Acceleration and enrichment of content as needed.
- Opportunities for differentiation, student collaboration, and project-based learning.
- Numerous, engaging electives are offered in special interest areas.
- Participation in advanced level classes.
- Enrollment opportunities in dual credit courses and On Ramps courses at the high school.
- Students send projects through Google Classroom to G/T specialists. These pieces are added to a digital portfolio for each student.
