Consider approval of the purchase of above-ground storage fuel tanks

1. Background

Southwest ISD Transportation Department is in need of replacing the current aging, 30-year-old fuel tanks, whose life expectancy will expire in July 2027. District staff is requesting to replace the current underground fuel tanks by purchasing two above-ground fuel tanks, DEF fluid tank, fuel dispensers, fleet management system, leak detection system, and other related hardware and service items to support the future fueling needs of Southwest ISD.

District staff consulted with JF Petroleum Group to evaluate replacing the current underground fuel tanks, related hardware, and services. JF Petroleum Group has replaced fuel tanks for several local San Antonio-area school districts, municipalities, and private businesses since 2018.

2. Process:

JF Petroleum Group is competitively procured through RFP 2223-125 Transportation Supplies, Equipment and Services, and pricing was obtained through the Sourcewell Cooperative Contract.

3. <u>Fiscal Impact:</u>

The total estimated contract amount will not exceed \$1,035,286 and funding will be through the 2023 Bond.

4. Recommendation:

That the Board approve purchasing above-ground fuel tanks, related hardware, and services from JF Petroleum Group, Inc.
