<u>School Pays – Salary</u> Benefits <u>10,149.52</u> Total \$ 40,074.40

<u>City Pays – Vehicle/Misc.</u> \$4,750.00 Vehicle, insurance, equipment, uniforms, office supplies, and training.

<u>School Gets –</u> 284 days off Officer Dykes – off 5 weeks during school year, holiday to <u>offset</u> security work (200 hrs.)

<u>City Gets – 81 days</u>

81 days = 11.57 weeks

Officer Dykes off 2-week's vacation, and 6 personal/sick days during summer months. \*Officer Dykes will also be in SRO related training during the summer months, taking away time from city.

5 week's/200 hrs. Holidays during school year – Thanksgiving, Christmas, Spring Break, Holidays, and work days.

200 hrs security = even trade

- \* Anything above 200 hrs school pay's security.
- \* Officer schedule 7:30 am 3:30 pm Monday Friday
- \* There are 6 early release days = 24 hrs.
- \* In the event, Officer Dykes has to work late, came in early, or is called back in to work. He will keep up with his hours, knowing that the first 24 hrs of extra time, he will not be compensated for or given time off. This will offset the above early release days.
- \* City not going to pay or give officer holidays (160 hrs), since officer will be receiving these days at school, and officer want be working for the city very much.
- \* City will pay all training expense, travel, lodging, meals, etc. for law enforcement training.
- \* School will pay all training expense, travel, lodging, meals, etc., for all school related training.
