<u>June 4</u> - This was the last day of school for students. We honored our 4th grade students, who are moving to middle school, with a 4th grade sendoff. We also honored multiple other groups for their hard work throughout the school year. In the afternoon we were able to celebrate the end of the year with an all school carnival.
