Learning Goals and Action Plans

1. 44% of Basin Online students will be proficient on benchmark assessments for Reading Standards 4 and 5 by Spring 2024.

Standard R.4: Read grade-level text with accuracy and fluency to support comprehension. (RL & RI)

Standard R.5: Cite relevant textual evidence to support analysis of what the text says explicitly as well as what inferences can be drawn from the text, including identifying where the text leaves matters uncertain. (RL & RI)

- Instructional videos will be embedded in courses with direct instruction on Close Reading Strategies.
- Students will complete Close Reading activities in all content areas: Kami software will be used in courses for annotations
- Teachers will share their Close Reading strategies with their PLC teams monthly and/or in faculty meetings
- Teachers will attend Professional Development Training on Literacy across all content areas
- Teachers will be paid a stipend of \$800 to create videos on Close Reading activities in all content areas and upload them into their courses.
