- TASB recently released Update 125 with revisions to Legal policies to align with changes in law and policy, as well as proposed Local policy revisions to align with updates to Legal policies and other administrative updates.
- Keller ISD's administration has also proposed an update to Local Policy CFB.

| BDAA | Officers and Officials: Duties and Requirements of Board Officers | Deletion of reference to assigning clerical assistance within Board Officers section to reflect that the superintendent, rather than the board, manages staff assignments, including support to the board. |
| BDB | Board Internal Organization: Board Committees | Revisions to align with recommendation addition of BDF (LOCAL) and provide clarification between board committees and advisory committees. |
| BDF | Board Internal Organization: Advisory Committees | New policy to provide clarification between board committees and advisory committees. |
| EI | Academic Achievement | Revisions to phrasing to more accurately reflect the determination of awarding credit when a student earns a passing grade only half of a course. |
| FDE | Admissions: School Safety Transfers | Addition of "bullying" as an offense for which district must collect and maintain data to align with the Unsafe School Choice Option Guidance Handbook. |
| FEC | Attendance: Attendance for Credit | Multiple revisions throughout to provide greater clarity. |
| FFAC | Wellness and Health Services: Medical Treatment | Updates to the rules on unassigned medication for respiratory distress to align with new Department of State Health Services rules. |
| FNCE | Student Conduct: Personal Communication Devices/ Electronic Devices | Updates to align policy with recently passed HB 1481. |

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| CFB | Accounting Inventories | Increase in the capitalization threshold for the purposes of classifying individual capital assets from \$5,000 to \$10,000 based on TEA guidance due to changes from the USDE. |
