DESCRIPTION:

Extended School Year (ESY) services are provided to students whose Individualized Education Program (IEP) includes the need for continued special education services during extended school breaks. Each year, IEP teams assess the need for ESY based on specific eligibility criteria to ensure students receive a Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE).

To qualify, students must currently be receiving special education services and have supporting data in one of three key areas:

- Evidence of significant skill regression during extended breaks, with a recovery period longer than the length of the break.
- A demonstrated need for services to maintain essential functional skills required for a reasonable level of personal independence.
- Unique circumstances where the IEP team determines ESY services are necessary to provide FAPE.

IEP teams continue to evaluate and discuss ESY eligibility with families throughout the school year. We are actively gathering information from staff to finalize the number of students who qualify for services. The figures below represent the current number of eligible students, as well as the number of staff members who have applied for ESY positions.
