Re: Wireless Access Additions

Please submit this purchase information to the BOE for the June 24, 2013 meeting.

During the past school year the technology department replaced all of the existing older technology access points with new AeroHive Wi-Fi devices. This project was a one-for-one replacement with the new access points placed in the same location as the previous one. Access points were also placed in the rooms of ESTART teachers to try and accommodate the wireless devices of their choice. While it has improved overall building wireless coverage, it does not address the trends the district projects for increased wireless demand.

Some of the trends the district and IT leaders everywhere see are: Proliferation of Mobile Devices, Multiple Devices per User, Always-On Connectivity, Wi-Fi as a primary Network Access Method, Bring Your Own Device or One-to-One Computing, and Cellular Network Offload. For these reasons, the district needs to move toward a High Density Wi-Fi design. Access points need to be moved from common areas and into the classrooms and conference rooms to accommodate a large number of mobile devices. The process of creating a district wide High Density Wi-Fi environment will occur over multiple school years. This year we are increasing the number of wireless access points by 25% at all district school facilities only.
