

TxVSN Dual Credit Information Relative to the 82nd Legislative Session Fall 2011

Dual Credit Highlights:

- Dual credit courses of tuition and fees, are inclusive at \$200 per three hour credit course enrollment.
- A scholarship of \$50 per three hour credit course to students receiving free or reduced price lunch at their home school can be awarded upon certification by the school of their eligibility for free or reduced price lunch. The scholarship will come in the form of a credit on the invoice to the districts for the semesters' tuition and fees.
- A school district with a class of 20 or more enrolled in the same course will get an additional 5% discounted tuition and fees for that course.
- **All tuition and fees are based on students enrolled by the "census" day for the semester as established Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board regulation.
- Supplemental resources such as The UTPB Dual Credit Mentor Program, Smart Thinking
 Online Tutoring, Technical Support for Blackboard users, Supplemental Instruction in selected
 courses, Writing Center assistance and tutorials with writing assignments, Electronic resources,
 online reference services, and other services of the J. Conrad Dunagan Library will apply and
 are available to assist all online dual credit students.
