DESCRIPTION:

The AVID Elective teachers have engaged in the district Continuous Improvement Process (CIP) review tasks over the past year in the PILOT phase. They have been active in activities that have included:

- committing to a vision statement to align and set our long term direction
- gap analysis in the areas of curriculum, systems and AVID vision to identify top priority needs
- determining success criteria and measurements for pilot ideas
- consensus-building discussions to reach implementation agreements

These CIP tasks have now culminated into a Curriculum Adoption Proposal (CAP) Report being presented to you for review at this time. The implementation plan included here provides excellent student opportunities that align with the goals of the program, as well as the local identified improvement goals.

This review process has allowed an opportunity for our AVID Elective teachers to reflect upon the future learning experiences desired for BHM students.
