9.4 APPROVAL OF LIFE SAFETY AMENDMENT FOR PAVING REPAIRS TO WOODSTOCK HIGH SCHOOL EXTERNAL RUNNING TRACK

A. <u>SUBJECT</u>

The Board is asked to review and approve a Life Safety Amendment for paving repairs on the running track at Woodstock High School.

B. INFORMATION

The Board approved the 10-year Life Safety Survey in February 2016. All Category A, B, and C items have been completed. Since that time, staff has been consulting with the District's architects to address other items that have been identified since the original survey.

It has been determined that the external running track at Woodstock High School needs repair. This was not noted on the original survey, is a safety hazard to students, and involves paving repair. Therefore, according to School Code and ISBE, the District must hold a Public Hearing, for which notification was posted in the Woodstock Independent on November 27, 2024, and the Board must approve a Life Safety Amendment for use of Health Life Safety funds for this project. Wold Architects has prepared the life safety amendment. Once the amendment is approved by the Board of Education, it will be forwarded to ISBE for approval.

C. <u>RECOMMENDATION</u>

The Superintendent recommends approval of a Life Safety amendment for paving repairs to the external running track at Woodstock High School.

D. SUGGESTED MOTION

Motion to approve the attached resolution and forward required documentation to ISBE authorizing use of Health Life Safety Funds for the repair of the external running track at Woodstock High School.
