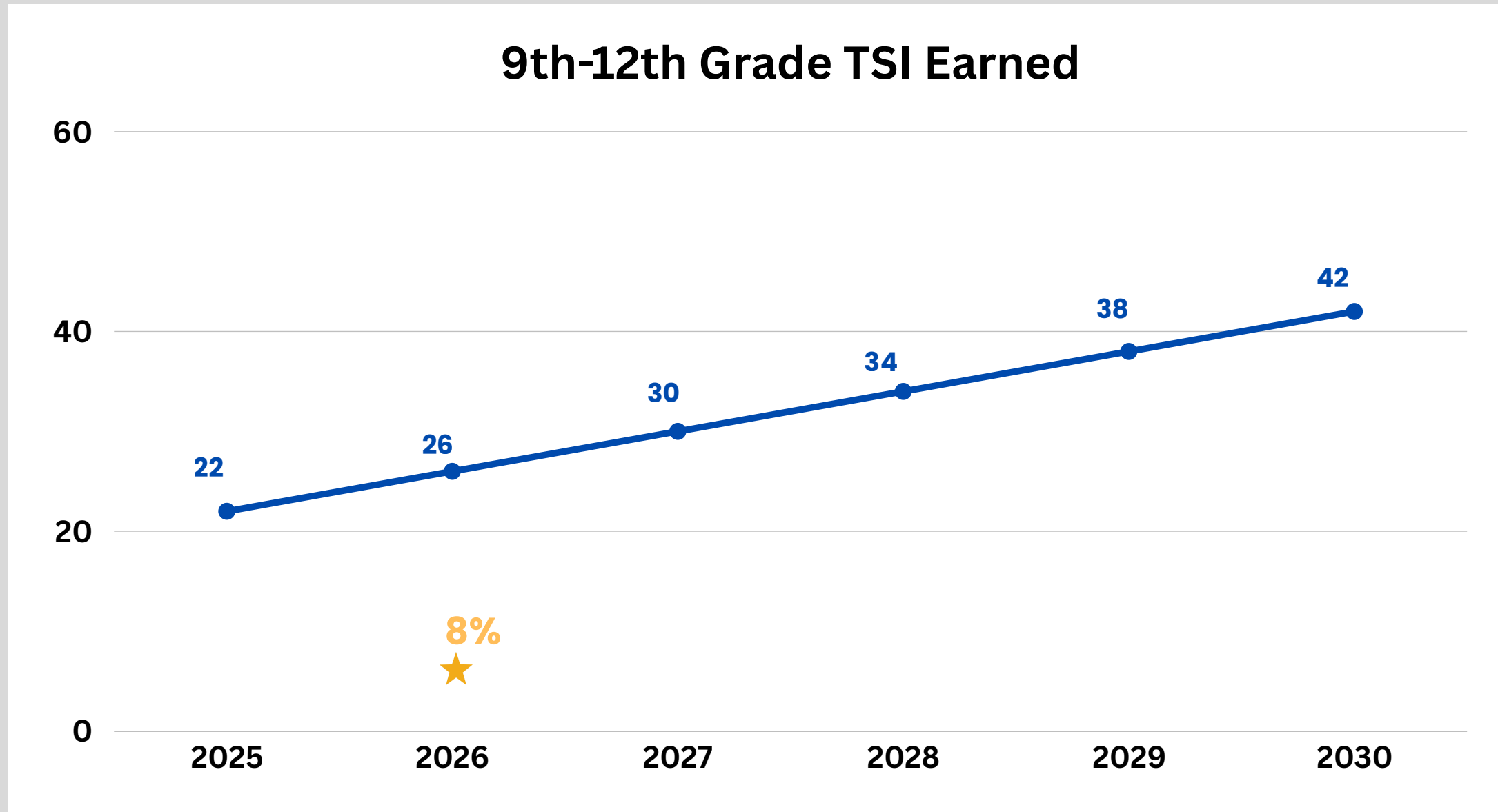

Goal 3: CCMR: SSAISD will increase the percentage of graduates who are college, career, or military ready (CCMR) from 61% in June 2025 to 92% by June 2030. (Current 2025: 61% | 2026: 67% | 2027: 80% | 2028: 88% | 2029: 90% | 2030: 92%)

Goal Progress Measure 3.3: The percent of 9th - 12th grade students that meet TSI criteria in both reading and math will increase from 22% in June 2025 to 42% in June 2030. (2025: 22% | 2026: 26% | 2027: 30% | 2028: 34% | 2029: 38% | 2030: 42%)

We are slightly off track because...

04/20/2026

- We are actively working to **review coding in multiple platforms** including Career Craft, Skyward, and OnDataSuite. There is a commitment to review and improve reporting protocols and procedures to support correct coding.
- **TSIA Reading: 14%**
- **TSIA Math: 8%**
- **Students are passing reading but not math** – this prevents both subject completion.

Specific Actions Taken

04/20/2026

- **Identifying student populations** within 5–10 points of the passing score
- **Implementing strict guidelines** to not permit advanced classes prior to TSI readiness– ECHS probationary Junior year if students have not passed TSI
- TSI Test Administrators taking the test themselves to gain familiarity with test format, types of questions
- **Recognition of success;** students earn certificates upon passing TSI test
- CCMR Guiding Coalition members including Director of Support Services, CTE Director, and CTE Coordinator **attended CCMR Forum** this month hosted by Region 20 **to stay informed of current CCMR guidelines.**

Future Intervention Measures

04/20/2026

- **Test students in earlier grades** rather than waiting until 12th grade year
- **Scheduled dates for Saturday Academies** include April 18th (part of STAAR Super Saturday at SSAHS) May 2nd, May 9th. Saturday test prep academies in May are open to 8th graders.
- **Saturday test administration** in May is open to 8th graders, as well as June 3rd Testing at SSAHS.
- Considering TSI is a difficult test, **chunking the test prep approach** with HQIM including IXL & Edgenuity platforms
- **Communications at 8th grade faculty meetings**, shared flyer for promotion in MS communications
- **Incorporate TSI prep into 8th grade Algebra I courses** following STAAR EOC testing at end of April
- **Retest date** of May 12th & 13th for those students who experienced technical difficulties with the Accuplacer platform on the March 3rd School Day Assessment administration

- **Communication opportunities** through Cafecitos, BOY Parent Night, Prep Day information table – educating all stakeholders about TSI.
- **Pilot section of Algebraic Reasoning Course** with 20–25 students who have passed Algebra I STAAR, not quite ready for Algebra II or Geometry, college bound students that will need TSI readiness skills
- **26–27 ECHS Summer Bridge Program** will focus on TSI English prep; TSI test administration on June 3rd. This will also be open to current Geometry students needing TSI.
