**Item Name:** CONSIDER APPROVAL OF RATIFICATION OF DONATIONS TO DISTRICT

**Item Summary:** The Board of Trustees delegates to the Superintendent the authority to accept unsolicited gifts on behalf of the District. However, any gift with a cost or market value of \$5,000 or more shall be presented to the Board for acknowledgment.

Gifts pending acknowledgment shall be accepted as received by the Superintendent, at his or her discretion, with a list of gifts of \$5,000 or more being presented to the Board on a quarterly basis.

Carter PTO donated \$6,540.78 to Carter Elementary School to send four teachers to the Ron Clark Academy.

Friends of Huggins donated \$42,500.00 to Huggins Elementary School for a shade structure and concrete slab.

Texas A&M donated \$6,750.00 to Terry High School for the WIT program.

The Rotary Club donated \$6,500.00 to the Innovative Learning Department to provide literacy opportunities for 3rd grade Title I students.
