
### Phonics Pilot Program for Pease and Zavala


**Why:** Systematic and explicit phonics instruction is more effective and makes a bigger contribution to children's growth in reading than instruction with non-systematic or no phonics instruction. The hallmark of explicit and systematic phonics instruction is the direct teaching of a set of letter- sound relationships in a clearly defined sequence. The set includes the major sound/ spelling relationships of both consonants and vowels.




# Pease Elementary Istation Data Jan. and March
