

## **Special Education Board Report: June 20, 2019**

### **Preschool Inclusion**

Another great year of preschool is in the books! Our early childhood special education teachers and paraprofessionals worked hard to end the year strong meeting transition and planning needs for all students individually. Students heading to Kindergarten received transition meetings with their local districts or school of choice for the fall to plan for students' needs. Families of students returning to preschool had meetings to discuss with families what their goals, as well as concerns, were for their students entering preschool. IEP meetings were held and plans were developed to support our students' success individually in their planned educational environment for the 2019-2020 school year.

### **0-3 Early Childhood Special Education Service (home & community based)**

The 0-3 team continues to work hard to support the needs of our counties youngest learners through Early On services. Our team continues to meet state compliance guidelines for timeliness of services and documentation, as well as the processing of referrals. During the 2018-2019 school year, the team processed 214 referrals from doctors, hospitals, parents, families, agencies and service providers for children with potential developmental concerns. Throughout the year, services have been provided to 131 students.

### **MoCI Programs**

We had two students who completed from Amanda Frank's classroom this school year and they both participated in the HCISD completion ceremony.

### **Greenfield**

Greenfield also had students that completed from our Young Adult Program (YAP) and Severely Cognitively Impaired Program (SXI) on May 29, 2019. We wish our students and families the best, and we miss them already!
