So You Think You Know the FBI? Briefing for Candidates

So You Think You Know the FBI?

Most of us have some notion of the FBI, and what that organization does, like protecting and defending against foreign or domestic threats, enforcing Federal criminal laws, and providing resources to federal, state, and municipal law enforcement agencies. But unknown to many of us, the FBI also has community outreach resources that can help school districts and communities to be safer places to live. Brad Ware, Community Outreach Specialist, from the FBI Field Office in Springfield will overview community outreach resources available through the FBI. Those resources include Citizen Academies, Community Relations Executive Seminars, Safe Online Surfing, Child ID App for mobile devices, help in planning for an active shooter response, and preventing gang related activities in communities. Mr. Ware will overview these free services in the hopes that school districts may want to tap into this valuable resource. We will have Q & A as time allows.
