Hands-on Learning Games for Students who Receive Special Education

*32 students with special needs will be impacted by providing them with an opportunity to learn in a fun way and to collaborate with peers while working towards learning the state standards. Collaboration among the elementary special education department will be inevitable and very much welcomed due to the varied ability levels of our students with special needs, and the fact that our students often have multiple special education teachers.

*This project will enhance the learning environment and promote academic excellence for students with special needs in social skills, reading, and/or math in the following ways: Students will benefit from instruction using these hands-on learning materials. Student learning is increased when a multi-modal approach (kinesthetic, auditory, visual, and tactile presentation) is used. Currently, students are taught using reading and math textbooks, and they are given multiple worksheets to complete for practice and to work towards mastery of the skill.

Project Activities: Description of the activities the award will facilitate and that will produce the objectives stated in the proposal.

*The award will facilitate students' academic and social emotional growth. Games require students to collaborate with their peers; skills such as turn taking, good sportsmanship, and following directions will be directly taught. Academic skills are integrated within each hands-on learning game. These games are sustainable; they will be used within our special education department for many years.

Plan for Evaluation and Follow Up: The standards of measurement to be used to determine if goal(s) have been achieved and timeline for assessment of results.

*Progress towards standards based IEP (Individualized Education Plan) goals in reading, writing, math and social skills are assessed a minimum of once a month for each student. Progress towards IEP goals is reported to parents each quarter alongside their report cards. Overall progress towards IEP goals are reviewed annually.
