

Results Driven Accountability

Results Driven Accountability (RDA) reports are a data-driven framework or scorecard used by the Texas Education Agency and the federal government to evaluate the performance and program effectiveness of school districts. Ideal performance levels are 0 or 1, signifying low risk or high compliance.

The RDA system assesses district performance across three primary program areas, focusing on students with unique needs:

- 1. Bilingual/English as a Second Language (B/ESL): Programs serving Emergent Bilingual (EB) students.
- 2. Other Special Populations: Includes students in Foster Care, Homeless, and Military families.
- 3. Special Education (SpEd): Programs serving students receiving special education services.
