Hard to believe it is already November!

In October we learned about Kelso's choices. Students worked on recognizing the size of the problem and worked on using Kelso's strategies for conflict resolution. We also covered student safety with our Child Protection Unit from Second Step. Students learned about



ways to stay safe with our “Never Never Rules” and the “Always Ask First Rule.” I encourage you to ask your child about the different Kelso’s choices and the never never rules, they know their stuff!

In November we will continue to work on skills for learning: focused attention, listening, following directions, being assertive, empathy and more. Additionally, we will continue developing using our ‘tools’ (Breathing, Listening & Words - so far) to help in solving problems and staying in the green zone. Mindfulness will continue to be incorporated into our SEL lessons this year. Practicing mindfulness is a great way to train our brains to regain focus and calm... I encourage you to practice this with your students at home. The more they practice, the more automatic a mindfulness response becomes.

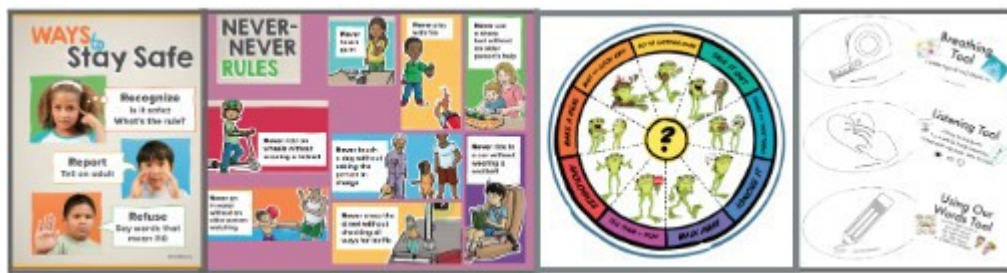

FlashAlert is the service we use to provide emergency closures to the Portland television and radio stations. The system will send you a text and/or email message. **(FAMILIES THAT SIGNED UP LAST YEAR WILL GET A MESSAGE WITH A LINK FOR THEM TO LOG IN AND RENEW THEIR SUBSCRIPTION, or you may log in and request a test message to revalidate your account.)** To subscribe to this service, go to our web site at <https://www.flashalert.net/login/> Under “Subscribe to receive FlashAlert messages from Neah-Kah-Nie Sch. Dist.” Type in your email address, click subscribe, confirm email address, create password, confirm password, click create account. You may enter up to three email addresses, or three text message numbers, or a combination of both. Once you have added your information click in the box that states “Click here” to send validation messages and complete the registration process. You also can download the iOS/Android app FlashAlert Messenger to your phones and link it to your account. Then click log out. If you need help with this process, contact your school secretary or Kathie Sellars at the District Office. You will need to make sure that your SPAM filter allows messages from info@flashalert.net.
