

CURRICULUM SUB-COMMITTEE REPORT

November 8, 2018

The Curriculum Sub-Committee was reconstituted as a standing committee of the Woodbridge Board of Education for the 2017-2018 school year. At that time, Board of Education Chair Margaret Hamilton assigned Lynn Piascyk to chair the committee and Maegan Genovese, and Nancy Maasbach as committee members. Joyce Shavers replaced Ms. Maasbach as a committee member in October 2018. The Woodbridge Education Association (WEA) sends a representative to committee meetings. The committee meets on a monthly basis. Faculty and administration provide presentations and overviews on curriculum at each meeting. These meetings are open to any interested member of the public. Ongoing discussions of the district's Curriculum Review and Revision Cycle occur.
