AGENDA ITEM: Consideration of Approval of a Resolution and Official Ballot Casting Votes for Candidates for the Collin Central Appraisal District Board of Directors

DISCUSSION: In accordance with the Texas Property Tax Code, the Appraisal District's five directors are to be elected by the taxing units that participate in the Appraisal District. Each taxing unit may nominate one to five board candidates. The District's Board of Directors serve two-year terms, with the next term beginning January 1, 2020.

Collin College is entitled to cast 194 votes among the ten (10) candidates for the five (5) open seats for two-year Board of Director terms beginning January 1, 2020.

DISTRICT PRESIDENT'S RECOMMENDATION: The District President recommends that the Resolution and Official Ballot casting votes for the Collin Central Appraisal District Board of Directors be approved.
