Recommendation:
The Curriculum and Instruction High School Department is requesting board approval to implement an Early College Academy at Alexander High School and United High School beginning in the 2023-2024 school year for incoming 9 <sup>th</sup> grade students.
Rationale: The AHS Early College Academy and UHS Early College Academy will each provide 100 students the opportunity to earn an Associate of Arts Degree (60 college hours) upon high school graduation. Appropriately, certified teachers currently at AHS and UHS will ensure tuition costs for the district are at a minimum level to support this initiative.
