SUBJECT: THIRD AND FIFTH GRADE FEBRUARY TAKS READING RESULTS

BOARD GOAL: Academic Excellence

FISCAL NOTE: None

Background Information:

- Test administered on February 21, 2007.
- Students in grades 3 and 5 are required to pass TAKS Reading as a promotion requirement. Fifth graders are also required to meet the passing standard for TAKS Math.
- In accordance with the requirements outlined in the Student Success Initiative, students who have not met passing standards on the February administration will have two additional testing opportunities: April 19 and June 28, 2007.
- Current data has not been disaggregated for accountability purposes.
- TAKS results were downloaded and available in Compass by March 13, 2007.

Administrative Considerations:

- The cumulative results for the first two administrations will be utilized for accountability.
- "Snapshot" students will be disaggregated and evaluated to determine State accountability ratings in early August 2007.
- Preliminary AYP (Adequate Yearly Progress), an annual report reflecting performance for all students, is scheduled for release in early August 2007 as well.
