Consider Approval of 2020 – 2021 Expedited and General State Waivers

SUMMARY:

This consent agenda item requests approval to apply for the Expedited and General State Waivers listed below for the 2020 - 2021 school year.

The following Expedited State Waivers are being recommended for approval:

• Staff Development

This waiver is for staff development in place of student instruction; therefore, the waiver minutes
are only applicable to staff development provided instead of student instruction during the school
vear.

Modified Schedule/State Assessment Testing Days

o This waiver allows the district or charter school to modify the schedule of classes for students who are not being tested to report to and attend school after the state assessment testing period has ended, therefore reducing the interruptions during testing period.

• Teacher Data Portal of the Texas Assessment Management System

o Districts that are interested in fulfilling the requirement of TEC, §32.258 to provide teacher access to student assessment data through a local student data system must apply for an expedited waiver from the Texas Education Agency (TEA).

Timeline for Accelerated Instruction

 To assist districts in meeting the accelerated instruction provision after the third administration of the test, the agency is allowing districts to apply for a waiver to adjust the timeline for providing accelerated instruction to students who fail the third administration

The following General State Waiver is being recommended for approval:

• Foreign Exchange Student (Less Than Five)

o This waiver allows districts and charter schools to limit the number of foreign exchange students to five or less per high school.
