Background Information:

- On December 17, 2007, a review of our local X policies was proposed by administration and discussed by the Board.
- Our Local X policies were previously developed with specificity to outline district practices prior to the implementation of Administrative Regulations.
- As discussed with the Board, the specificity of our X policies challenge us in writing regulations and are more operational instead of governance in nature which increases our risk for non-compliance.
- The Board determined that an X policy review would be in the best interest of the district and Cindy Lotton served as the Board representative on the committee.
- The Local X Policy review Committee met on March 28, 2008.

Other Local Policy Revisions:

- DAA is being revised to recognize change in personnel.

Administrative Considerations:

- All of the local X policy revisions have been reviewed by the administration and are in the process of review by the District's legal counsel in order to ensure that they reflect the practices of the district and the intentions of the Board.
- Included with this cover sheet is an annotated copy of each local policy with recommended revisions.
- These policies will be considered for Board action on April 28, 2008.
