Consider approval of additional curriculum/awareness for the Prevention of Human Trafficking for primary grades.

1. Background:

Senate Bill 9 (SB9) of the 87th Legislative Session requires school districts to offer curriculum to students in the prevention of child abuse (elementary & secondary), family violence (elementary & secondary), dating violence (secondary), and sex trafficking (secondary). The SHAC recommends having consistent proactive measures and curriculum content for primary and secondary levels.

2. <u>Process:</u>

The Board of Trustees will review the SHAC recommendations for additional Human Trafficking Curriculum/Awareness for primary grades and consider approval.

3. Fiscal Impact:

The Ransomed Life (Mouse Traps) program is currently free. A donation is suggested.

4. <u>Recommendation:</u>

That the Board approve the SHAC recommendations regarding health education curriculum and instruction related to Human Trafficking.

5. <u>Required:</u> Board action.
