Subject: Extracurricular Safety and Security Police Officer Services – Cooperative Contract(s) and Interlocal Cooperation Contract(s)

Background Information:

- Off-duty police officers are contracted for the safety and security of students during Lewisville ISD extracurricular events, including, but not limited to, sporting events, graduations, student dances, color runs, drill team shows, and fine arts concerts.
- On June 9, 2025, the Board of Trustees approved the use of School Resource Officers (SROs) for the 2025–2026 school year for the cities of Carrollton, The Colony, Highland Village, Lewisville, and the Town of Flower Mound. The District has found that SRO programs have served the common public interest of both Lewisville ISD and the respective municipalities by addressing juvenile delinquency, developing positive relations between students and law enforcement officers, and assisting the District in maintaining a safe, orderly, and secure learning environment.
- Lewisville ISD currently utilizes vendors that provide off-duty scheduling software to coordinate police officer assignments for extracurricular events in both the City of The Colony and the City of Carrollton. In Highland Village, the SROs provide security at events. The District uses an interlocal agreement with the City of Lewisville and the Town of Flower Mound to schedule services directly with these municipalities.
- The Flower Mound Police Department has added a 4-hour minimum to this year's agreement. All varsity football and basketball games are projected at 4-hour time slots. Sub-varsity football is projected at 4.5-hour time slots. Basketball games have not been scheduled. Total estimated cost in the agreement with the Town of Flower Mound is \$40,704. This does not include any extra events the District may request outside of football and basketball.

Administrative Consideration:

- Funds for these services will come from the Safety and Security, Athletics, and campus approved budgets.
- Previous annual expenditures:
 - 2025–2026: \$701,452
- Estimated annual expenditures: \$720,000 but will not exceed the approved budgets.
 - The specific amount spent will vary based on the number of extracurricular events that occur during the 2026–2027 school year.

- This procurement complies with Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code and with Section 44.031 of the Texas Education Code.

Recommendations:

- That the Lewisville ISD Board of Trustees approves the use of Lewisville ISD-eligible cooperative contract(s) and interlocal cooperation contract(s) to provide vendor(s) for extracurricular safety and security police officer services and the estimated expenditures for one year.
